There was a discussion about part-time officer availability. An Officer has stated availability any day in August; however, the Chief is not comfortable scheduling without knowing when they want to work to prevent no-shows. There was a discussion about the use of the overtime budget; \$4,200 used of the \$5,000 budget. Once the overtime budget is gone, the part-time funds will be used to fund the overtime. The Chief mentioned using part-time hours as coverage during a Family Medical Leave Act absence (FMLA).

Note: The 2021 part-time budget is \$4,000, which is 18 hours per month. \$952 has been used through the end of July. The 2020 part-time budget was 10 hours per week, \$8,840. Since \$3,194 was used, the 2021 budget was adjusted.

The meeting adjourned at 8:30 pm with no further business with a unanimous vote on Matt Treon's motion (2nd, Joe Claar).
