CD Rates: S&T Bank Certificate of Deposit: On a motion by Joe Claar (2nd, Alex Musselman), the Supervisors authorized Ami Fether, Township Secretary-Treasurer, to deposit \$150,000 from the First National Bank Money Market plus \$500,000 from our First National Bank CD that is maturing on 11/22/23 into a public funds CD with S&T Bank for a twelve (12) month term and 5.32% APY.
